Can arrive after 8 AM on Friday, August 16th

Stalls/Camping:

Stalls are required, shavings will be provided -- \$20 per stall per night. No tack stalls available. Stalls will be assigned. Please plan to bring fans.

**Please note there will also be a \$50 deposit for each stall. The deposit will be refunded back to your payment method after you have vacated the stall and it has been inspected for cleanliness.

Stall payment example: 2 horses for 2 nights, total payment is (\$20 x 2 stalls x 2 nights) + (\$50 deposit x 2 stalls)= \$180 total payment (\$100 will be returned if your stalls are clean).

Refunds will be issued the week following the fair. You are responsible for cleaning your stalls before you leave – this includes complete removal of shavings!

Manure must be dumped in designated areas.

Camping will be in the back field by the old white barn.

There is a \$15 per night camping fee

- No electric hook-ups are available (generators permitted)
- Water connection is not guaranteed but water is available on site

Admission:

No charge

Check In:

Check ins will start at 2:00 pm. Remember, the first check in of the season tends to take longer with back number assignment, handbooks, logo policies, etc so plan accordingly!

Be prepared to pay all rodeo entry fees at this time.

All contestants must be in dress code at check in.

MDHSRA State Dues

The first half of MDHSRA State Dues are due October 1. State dues will now be tracked via the EquestEvent system. Look for the "Dues" event under the appropriate "Add On" category to add your dues to your event fees total. You can then pay either online with a credit card, or on site at a rodeo via Paypal.

Mandatory Contestant Meeting:

Contestant meeting will be at 4:00 pm in the grandstands.

Entry Fees:

Entry fees are required for EACH day and must be paid during check-in.

JR High/High School:

Rough Stock: \$70.00

Timed events: \$35.00

Mustangs:

Barrels, Poles and Goat Tying: \$25.00

Rough Stock: \$45.00

Breakaway and Team Roping: \$35.00

Remember to have Coggins and out-of-state health certificates available for inspection by the State vet.

- •Back Number (Contestants only, worn on your back!)

(Volunteers working in the arena and waiting with contestants near the entry gate are also required to be in dress code)

<u>Curfew:</u> There will be a 10:00 pm curfew. Any contestant needing to leave the campground area (including to go to the barn) MUST be accompanied by a parent or adult chaperone
