# CONTESTANTS' MEETING INFO

#### **Ground Rules**

- ALL Contestants must check in prior to first run. Any runs made without checking in will be no time.
  - NJ AND VA- PLEASE CHECK IN WITH YOUR STATES
  - MD, PA, NY- PLEASE CHECK IN AT THE RODEO OFFICE in Quillen Arena
- Know the order of events and know your draw. We have a few "same/ sound alike names".
   Please confirm/ acknowledge your name with volunteers running the gate
- No schooling horses in the arena. If you break pattern, you must leave the arena.
- Team roping- allowed two loops total. (one loop each roper)
- Breakaway
  - o HS- Bell Collar catch ONLY, can carry 1 loop.
  - JH/Mustang follow the rule book for JH- 1 loop
- Tie Down- can carry 1 loop
- All roping event contestants, push stock to end gate/pen to help speed things up.
- Alley is part of the arena.
  - Straight in and straight out. Do not circle in the arena.
  - Controlled pace entering the arena.
  - o Please keep the back open so contestant can get in
- Barrels, Poles, Goats- there will be a time limit of 1 min and 30 sec to get in the gate
- Barrels and Poles will drag every 10 and between divisions.
- Goats you may line up we are running 1 goat
  - Mustangs MUST flank their own goats
- Protest for an event must be made by the contestant through the event director during the event that is in question.
- Score line for roping events and barrel pattern measurements will be posted at the rodeo office
- Arena is closed after the start of SLACK on Friday Afternoon. No one in the arena unless approved by the arena director. The outdoor arena is open and can be used at any time.

### General

#### Stalls

- No Tack Stalls
- All Unused stalls will be zip tied shut. Do NOT unzip tie. If found unzip tied, you or your state will be charged \$80
- Any stall that is used (regardless of what it was used for- horse, tack, shavings, etc) will be charged \$80
- Shavings must be used
- You DO NOT need to clean out stalls before you leave.

#### **Results/Stock Draws**

- The official draw & Stock draws will be posted at the rodeo office 1 hour prior to each slack/ perf. They will also be available on Equest Event
- All results will be posted after each Slack/ Perf on Equest Event. Result ranking is not final until after the last slack run of the performance for that event.

#### **Dress Code**

- Back Numbers must be visible during your run
- All Assistants must be in dress code including boots
- All volunteers in the arena must be in dress code- including boots
